Her first book, *Captive in Iran*, which recounts her capture and imprisonment, was published in April 2013. Marzi has shared her inspiring story in the United States and around the world, in order to bring awareness to people and policy makers about the ongoing human rights violations and persecution of religious minorities in Iran. Marzi's primary mission is to warn fellow Americans that freedom must be cultivated and defended. Marzi feels deep gratitude for this country and its people which have given her so much. She feels a responsibility to stand up, serve, and encourage her fellow Americans to fight for their values, faith, and freedom. Marzi's second book, *A Love Journey with God*, was recently released and is available on Amazon. *A Love Journey with God* recounts how Marzi found God, the struggles she experienced as a Christian woman in an Islamic County, and how God can turn any situation into triumph. 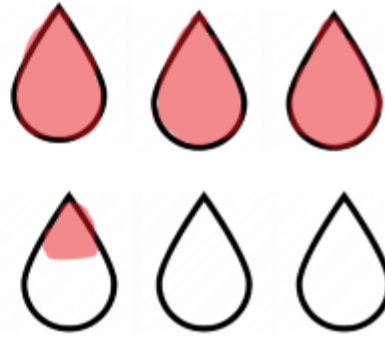

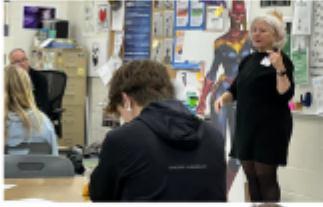

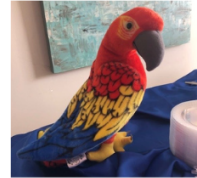
