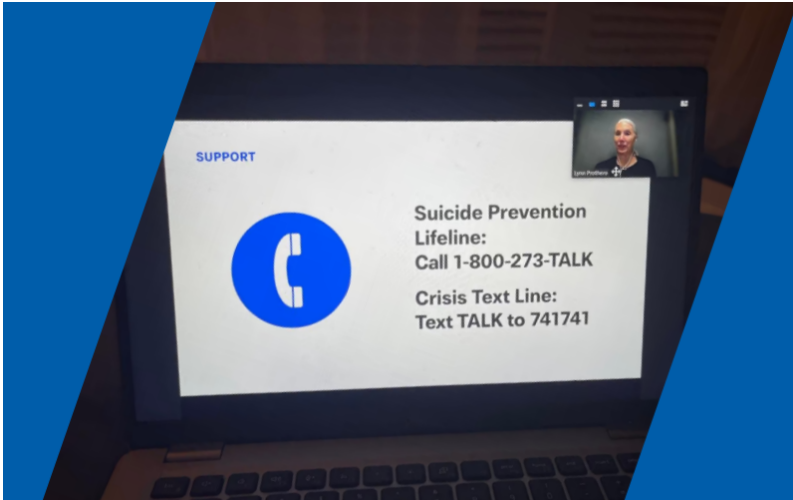


RRAH Meeting Recap + Friendsgiving
