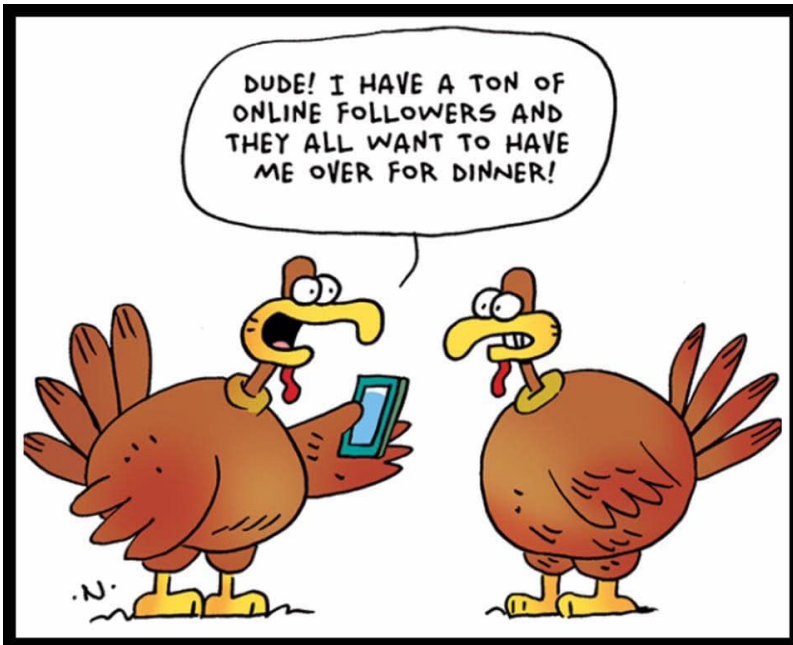


President Alex's Message
