But Dale's commitment to consumer protection doesn't end there.

Dale and his team also investigate and expose bad companies that intentionally harm consumers. Dale lives in DeKalb county, Georgia with Angie, his wife of 33 years. The couple have two adult children who live with their spouses in Atlanta.
