Rev. Donald Mathis will be our speaker. Rev. Mathis is a member of the board of directors for the Vashti Center, and he will talk to us about the programs offered and the children supported by Vashti. He completed a five-year program and received a diploma in ministry from Candler School of Theology at Emory University before continuing his education and receiving an associate's degree in sociology from Waycross College. He later graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in social work from Savannah State University, where he was inducted into the National Honor Society. He is also an alumnus of Saint Leo University, where he received a master's degree in social work focused on advanced clinical practice and was inducted into the Phi Alpha Honor Society.

Rev. Mathis has been in pastoral ministry for 24 years and has pastored many congregations. But he is equally active in the community. He has worked with the Wesley Foundation Campus Ministry, the Urban Hope After School Program, and the Board of Missions in Savannah.
