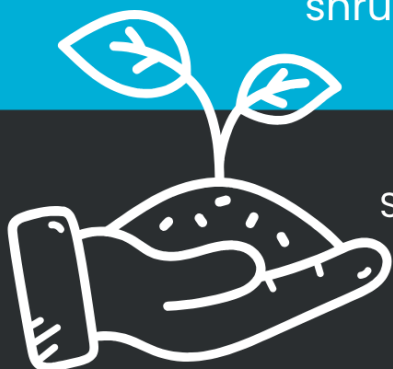


Habitat for Humanity North Central Georgia is in need of volunteers who want to further our mission of building homes, communities, and hope.
